

## Cutting with the CutWork Tool

This pattern is meant to cut out pieces in a pattern.

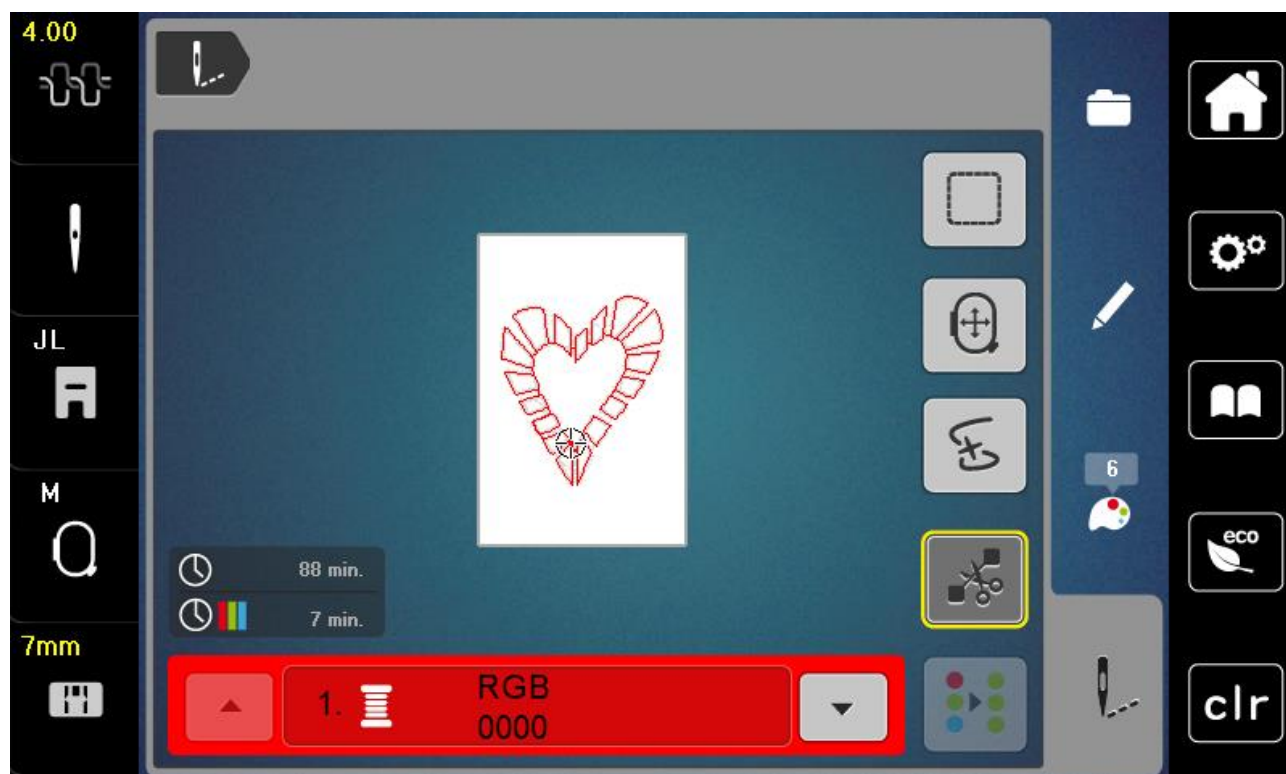
Spray the fabric 2-3 times with starch (follow the manufacturer's instructions). The fabric needs to be firm for cutting.

Use glue spray to affix a piece of water-soluble stabilizer to the fabric.

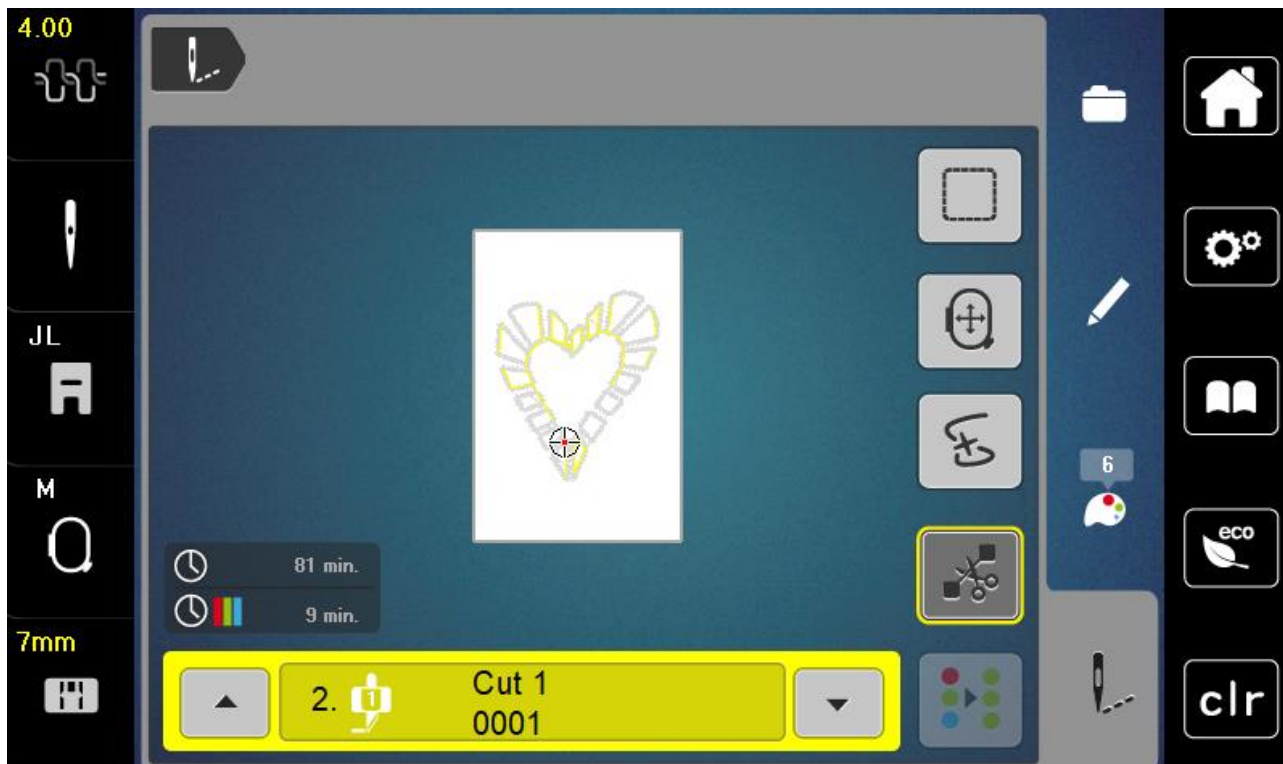
Insert fabric and stabilizer in the hoop.

Open the pattern «Bernina\_015\_heart».

First embroider the stabilizing run with regular embroidery thread.



Next pieces will be cut out.

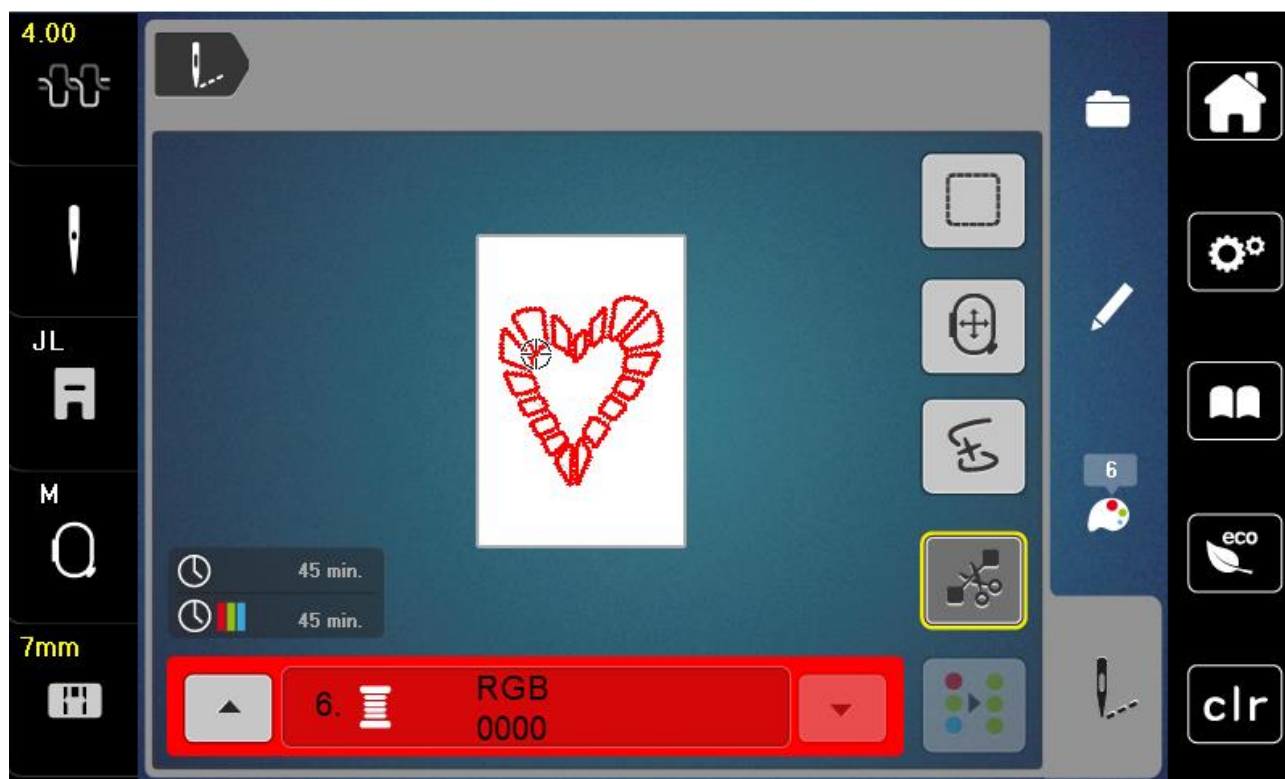


For this, insert the CutWork Tool instead of the needle. Very important: The knife must be in position 1. If not, rotate the knife to that position



Once position 1 is finished cutting, simply turn the knife and cut positions 2 through 4. Remove the pieces which have been cut out.

Finally, insert a needle instead of the CutWork tool and embroider over the cutout edges with regular embroidery thread.



Once finished follow the manufacturer's instructions to remove the stabilizer.
